Time is running out to get your annual flu shot or other routine vaccinations.

Depending on the vaccine, it may be fully covered by your insurance. Please check with Capital Rx by calling the number on the back of your ID card to confirm your coverage and responsibility.

Examples of routine vaccines available and covered by your insurance plan:

- Influenza (flu)
- COVID-19
- RSV (Respiratory Syncytial Virus)

Where can I get more information?

Your health care provider is the best source of information. They know you, your medical history and whether a specific vaccine is right for you.

Is my school offering an onsite clinic?

Many employers offer an onsite clinic for flu shots and other vaccinations. Check with your Human Resources department.

Visiting your local pharmacy for your vaccine shot?

While an appointment is not always needed, you can call your local pharmacy or go to their website to make an appointment.
