Your employer will be implementing Rx Cap for members using high-cost specialty medications. This plan enhancement connects you with programs to help lower your copays. You may be told you have a high out-of-pocket cost for these medications, but this will be lowered following enrollment in a copay assistance program.

How does Rx Cap Work?



Once your pharmacy[†] receives your prescription:

- Your pharmacy will contact you to verify if you have previously enrolled in a copay assistance program(s).
 - · If you were previously in a copay assistance program, the pharmacy will use the same billing information provided to you from the manufacturer.
 - · If this is your first time signing up, the pharmacy representative will work with you and your provider to complete your enrollment in the program.
 - If you are told by the pharmacy there is a large copay for your medication, the pharmacy may need to apply the billing information from the copay assistance program. Your out-of-pocket costs for your specialty medication could be as little as \$0 [‡].
